

Telehealth Equity & Social Determinants of Health: A Community Engagement Project for Vulnerable Populations Using Telehealth

Overview of Project

During disasters all populations are vulnerable, and telehealth services may have significant limitations. This project will provide assessment of health in a community of vulnerable populations. It provides information and tools for implementing telehealth services where there are limited resources, such as in disaster situations.

Objectives

1. Assess telehealth equity in a community of vulnerable populations.
2. Engage with community to assess health information processes in a disaster.
3. Pack a go-bag using mobile technology without connectivity.
4. Consider future global telehealth as a means of providing equitable health to underserved communities.
